News from Greens

Handicap Revisions Calculation

According to the USGA Handicap system, a player's handicap Index (HI) will be revised if two or more tournament scores (posted within the past year) are at least three strokes better than his/her current Handicap Index (based on the most recent twenty submitted scores).

Tournament Scores (T-Scores) are kept for a minimum of one calendar year from when they are posted or longer if they are still within a player's current 20-score history.

At each handicap revision, the most recent twenty (20) scores as calculated, are weighed against the average of the two best T-Score differentials. If the difference of both T-Score differentials is at least three strokes lower than the Handicap Index (as calculated from the most recent 20 scores), the player's Handicap Index will be reduced.

A player whose handicap has been revised because of exceptional tournament scores will have an "R" reflected after the Handicap Index.

Course Upgrading Project (CUP)

Work on the excavation of pond at the LHS 7th/16th fairways will commence after 15 August 2011. There will be heavy movement of workers and machinery. Golfers' understanding and co-operation will be much appreciated for any inconvenience caused.
