Greens & Fairways

The Handicap Sub-Committee has noticed that the majority of participants in the recent Changi Cup (Individual Match Play) Competition failed to submit scorecards after completing their matches.

This is contrary to Section 5-1.c. of the USGA Handicap System. Scores in all forms of competition MUST be posted. This includes scores made in match play, stroke play, multi-ball, stableford or in team competitions in which players have not completed one or more holes or in which players are requested to pick up when out of contention on a hole.

The score recorded for such holes should be the most likely score for the hole but no more than that allowed by Equitable Stroke Control.

Bits & Pieces from Club Manager's Desk

Usage of Buggies - Drive with care

Now that the 7th/16th tee box is assessable by buggy, golfers are reminded to drive with care when driving down from the tee box. Exercise more caution when there is rain and the slope is wet. Better be safe than sorry.



During weekends, particularly when there are club events, the golf course may be crowded. At the start of the afternoon session, when the morning golfers are finishing their game, the buggy track between the 18th green and the 1st/10th fairway and 9th/18th green, and the area in front of #345 is often congested with buggies and golfers.

Members are reminded to drive carefully and to refrain from speeding.

Car Parking

A Mercedes Benz with a CGC car label on the windscreen caught my eye as I walked by under the scorching heat. I recognized the car. It belongs to one of our members and he would have been walking the course by then.

As the Club house car park was full, and there was no more space along the “LTA-authorized area of Netheravon Road near CGC” (on weekends only), this member had driven next door to the Singapore Civil Service Club (SCSC) carpark. Many other members refuse to do so despite the arrangements for CGC members to enjoy a discounted rate at the SCSC carpark.
