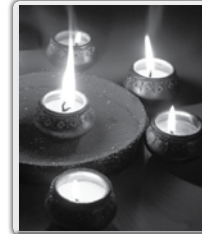

All golfers must register with the starter before commencing play. We want to ensure that your presence on the course is properly recorded. The Starter has a duty to ensure that all golfers have safely returned before the course is closed for the day.
