Bits & Pieces from Club Manager's Desk

From the R&A Rules of Golf, excerpt :

The Spirit of the Game

Golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

Safety

Players should not play until the players in front are out of range. If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, he should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning is "Fore".

Pace of Play

Play at good pace and keep up.

Players should play at a good pace. The Committee may establish pace of play guidelines that all players should follow.

It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and it is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in the group. Where a group has not lost a clear hole, but it is apparent that the group behind can play faster, it should invite the faster moving group to play through.

Priority on the Course

Unless otherwise determined by the Committee, priority on the course is determined by a group's pace of play. Any group playing a whole round is entitled to pass a group playing shorter round. The term "group" includes a single player.

Conclusion; Penalties for Breach

If players follow the above guidelines, it will make the game more enjoyable for everyone.

If a player consistently disregards these guidelines during a round or over a period of time to the detriment of others, it is recommended that the Committee considers taking appropriate disciplinary action against the offending player. Such action may, for example, include prohibiting play for a limited time on the course or in a certain number of competitions. This is considered to be justifiable in terms of protecting the interest of the majority of golfers who wish to play in accordance with these guidelines.

Up Periscope

The periscope at the 1st tee box is to assist golfers to see that the 1st / 10th green is cleared before taking their tee shot. It has been observed that some members were not only looking through the periscope but were trying to oscillate the structure with physical force. The periscope is a static structure and cannot be moved, shaken or lengthened.

The Weather Shade

Some of you may have noticed that the Golfers' Terrace has a full line of motorized vertical drop sunscreen shade. These shades are not constructed to ward off gusty winds and slashing rain. When there is intermittent downpour or strong sunlight the shades will be released to shade away the elements and provide some relief for the members lounging in the Golfers' Terrace.

Around the Greens

Ground Under Major Repair Phase 1

The ground before the 5th/14th green has sunken considerably, although not visible to the untrained eye. After a strong downpour there are pockets of residue rain water around this area. Work will commence after 3 December 2012, to elevate the ground with new soil and to improve the underground drainage system. New manholes will be constructed to direct the flow of surface water to the pond. This whole repair ground will be declared GUR and player must drop the ball at the DROP Zone, without penalty.

The repair work is scheduled to take 4 - 5 weeks. There will be heavy trucks transporting earth to the worksite; noise from the excavation works and workers movement. All these could distract your play and we thank you in advance for your understanding and co-operation. When the work is completed golfers will get to experience new challenges here. While the work is in progress golfers will be reminded to follow safety signs and marshal's instructions.
