Away Golf Games

Kluang Golf Club will be hosting CGC on Sunday 8 September 2012 and a large group of Changians is expected to sign up. Last year the Kluangians were hosted by Changians at CGC.

Kluang is a 9-hole course like Changi, and to accommodate 18-20 flights in an afternoon session would call for a shotgun tee off so that all the golfers will be able to return to the clubhouse on time for the evening's social. With over-whelming response, Changians are reminded on the need to exercise the registration priority.

Under the Club's Bye-laws 8.14: AWAY GAMES

- Members drawn to represent the Club in an "Away Game" are to give at least seventy-two (72) hours notice before the date of the competition if they are unable to play.
- Priority will be based on the following:
 - Members who register on the entry list and are part of the Management Committee.
 - Members who register on the entry list and hosted the visiting team.
 - Members who register on the entry list and hosted other visiting teams.
 - Members who register on the entry list and are placed on the reserve list.

So if you want to be included in away games, start to play the gracious host and avoid disappointment.

'Home Club' Penalty

Some members who are members of other golf clubs have nominated Changi as their "Home Club" where their handicap is held. The Handicap Sub-Committee wishes to remind these members to ensure that their CGC membership number is reflected on any scorecards submitted for games played at the other clubs.

Changi has limited staff resource, and a lot of time is wasted by having to look up members Changi Membership No. All future cards submitted with incorrect or incomplete information will incur a Penalty Score for the member concerned.

Course Etiquettes

A member's (name withheld to protect the brave) encounter with a father and son on the course. Apparently this member was much irked by the father teaching junior the finer points of the golf swing than the art of filling up fairway divots and repairing ball marks on the green.

On tee box 15 (drink hole), the junior took 6 practice swings, swiping a divot each time. When he finally hit it, the ball went into the water. Dejectedly he just walked towards the buggy. The member shouted at the senior to repair the divots, which the son reluctantly did.

Member mentioned that about a year ago, he had talked to the senior concerning junior's course etiquettes. Evidently nothing much has change.

A message to any adult member bringing their siblings to any course, not just in Changi - it is not the impressive drives and difficult to execute flopped shots, but the lasting impressions of good course etiquettes.
