### Course Hygiene and You

### Smoking Prohibition

Reminder, dated 21 January 2013, to comply with smoking prohibition in Changi Golf Club.

Smoking is prohibited by law in any discotheque, pub, bar, lounge or night club in any premises or building (including private club), except at designated outdoor smoking corners or designated smoking rooms approved

by NEA. Failure to comply is an offence and the smoker/s can be fined up to \$1,000 for the first offence and up to \$2,000 for each of the subsequent offences. Any person who hinders, obstructs, threatens, abuses, molests or assaults any person in the performance of his duties has committed an offence and can be fined up to \$1,000 and/or jailed up to 6 months.
