Shoe Wash Bay

Snippets from The New Paper

Last year, around 19,000 tickets were issued to offenders caught for smoking at prohibited areas. And out of this number 2,600 were dished out in food establishments. More than 32,000 places now prohibit smoking. The Government cannot watch over every location or respond to all reports of smoking in prohibited places. The onus lies on operators and managers of smoke-free premises who have a legal duty to stop patrons from smoking. In cases where they do not stop smoking or leave the premises, the operator or manager of the premises can seek assistance from the NEA. 400 enforcement actions have been taken out by NEA against operators and managers of premises who “had not fulfilled their duty under the law”.
