A flurry of activities in the main office certainly kicked up some dust as preparations for the Annual General Meeting begin to peak. In fact, base work started in the beginning of the year, sourcing for printers, audits, running through the Club Rules etc.

On the golf course, we began putting up nets to prevent errant shots towards Village Hotel. So far, they told us that they do not have any issues with golf balls coming from our course. We have also installed a new lightning alert system that relies on NEA's antennas installed island wide. Our golf course location has been plotted to provide lightning alerts within reasonable radius to balance play and safety in the event of an approaching storm.

Our course maintenance team is currently working on some products in the fertilizer and chemical category. The products introduced to us have to go through a process to test out samples and understand how it works. We are no botanists, but at this stage, they look promising in terms of improving course maintenance process and resilience for our beloved turf. As we take little steps towards improving our course, we remind all golfers, to refrain from stressing our turf by practicing chipping and pitching while waiting to tee off.

Changi Golf Club, has 9 holes that uniquely winds itself around the contours of the land. We are a private club that has public and service roads cutting across. We are proud of our members who constantly provide safety tips to visiting golfers. It helps especially with the way some of our golf holes cross each other. Every bit of courtesy and graciousness from all of us, can generate joy to time spent at the club. Let's maintain the Changi Spirit and truly live the "Changi Experience".
