Dear fellow CGC members,

We are writing to give you a heads-up on the membership survey which Keppel Club will be sending out to their members sometime in mid-August 2018. The survey aims to seek members' input, preference and choice on the future of the Keppel Club, and one of the options tabled will be the proposed merger with Changi.

CGC's stand is clear from the on-set: our primary focus is to secure CGC's lease extension till 2040 with Singapore Land Authority; and, any merger proposal will have to be voted on and accepted by CGC membership population, through an AGM or EOGM.

Keppel has included some artist impressions of what a new CGC clubhouse and facilities might look like in their coming survey. This, again, is merely for the purposes of illustrating to their members what the future might hold. This does not represent in any way that the proposed merger is confirmed nor that we have agreed on any of these plans.
