Editor's Column

When I first joined Changi Golf Club in 2005, the monthly subscription was \$70. As this had been unchanged for a very long time, it was raised to \$90 in September 2008 and has remained there for almost 10 years.

Significant cost increases can be seen by just comparing expenditure for property taxes, rental (for Building 345) security guards, utilities and foreign worker levy. In 2006, this expenditure was \$231,000 n had risen to \$357,000 (+54.5%) in 2016. Payroll cost in 2006 was \$781,000, rising to \$1,000,000 (+ 28.0%) in 2016.

With increases in cost of living and cost of doing business over the last 10 years, a revision in monthly subscription at CGC would have to be considered both reasonable and inevitable.
