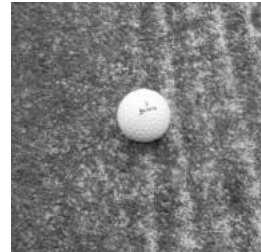
## Flag-Up ≠ Tee-Up Patience Please Safety First Thank You!

With the new rule on putting without the need to remove the flagstick, we remind golfers to ensure the greens & fairways are **clear** and the flight ahead is **out of range**, before teeing off & making your shot. This is especially so on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> (10<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>) tees.

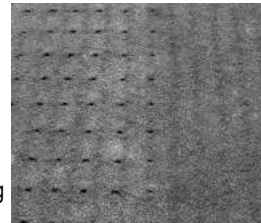
## Wondered why are there lines, holes & a layer of sand on our greens?

This is because we have been "scarifying, hollowtining & top-dressing" them!

**Scarification** or scarifying the greens is the process of removing unwanted lateral growth of grass on putting greens. This process involves slicing the grass surface, removing dead plant material, opening up the surface and encouraging grass to grow upright. **Verticutting** is a less aggressive and more refined version of scarification. As a result, green cutting becomes more efficient allowing the ball to roll easily and smoothly. Scarification also helps to prevent and control fungal diseases, makes the greens less susceptible to pest attacks, reduces localised dry patch and removes excess thatch.



**Hollowtining** (or Hollow Tyneing) follows scarification. Hollowtining is also referred to as "coring" – this involves punching or coring holes on the green. This is another thatch removal procedure while breaking the hard crust on the surface of the green and relieving the green of compaction. Hollowtining promotes air movement, nutrient and water absorption, stem and root growth, thereby optimising healthy grass growth. **Topdressing** the greens or filling the cores with fresh medium or sand completes the entire green treatment regime.



This regiment of scarification, verticutting, hollowtining and top-dressing is usually done at least twice a year, before and after the monsoon raining season, and prolonged dry spells.



# Safety on the 7th Hole

For your safety & the safety of your fellow golfers:

When you are playing on the 7<sup>th</sup> fairway, please park your buggy in the designated area on the track (near the 100m marker), so that the flight behind you is aware that you are still within "firing range". Please ensure the flight ahead is **clear and out of range** before teeing off. **Thank you!**
