As you all know, Changi Golf Club (CGC), like every other golf club in Singapore, will not resume operations in Phase 1 of the circuit-breaker easing. Nevertheless the Club's executive team has been working hard to ensure safe management measures are in place.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING: 26 JULY 2020

To align with Registry of Societies' Alternative Arrangement Order, this year's Annual General Meeting (AGM) has been scheduled for **Sunday 26 July 2020, 15:00hrs**. There will be several procedural changes to our AGM, such as: an online web-conference AGM and proceedings limited to statutory-required resolutions and elections. Members may email their questions on the resolutions and the Management Committee's (MC) responses will be posted on our website. AGM notice periods have been recalibrated to facilitate these changes.



Note that the **deadline for nominations** for the next 2020/2022 MC will be **Sunday 05 July 2020, 18:00hrs**.

Please be reminded that members must ensure their accounts are in credit to participate in the coming AGM.

We will be communicating with all members on the updated procedure for the coming AGM together with the Notice of Annual General Meeting soon.

SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES

The Management Committee (MC) will be implementing a set of safe management measures to ensure the health and safety of our members, staff and stakeholders. These include:

- If unwell, seek medical attention and stay at home
- Use of Safe-Entry registration on entering and exiting the Club's premises
- Temperature taking and access control
- Strictly no private parties, competitions and celebrations
- Exercising safe distancing and practising personal hygiene at all times
- Prior booking of tee-times for weekday, weekend, 9-hole and 18-hole plays
- Strictly no walk-in registrations
- Increased tee-time intervals
- No alternate tee-off on 1st/10th tees
- Golfers will need to handle their own golf bags and belongings, including loading on and unloading off golf buggies

The Club will continue to suspend all club golf and social events, including competitions, and, close some of our facilities.



Clubhouse, food and beverage operations, and, use of buggies will be updated as and when we receive the Ministry of Health's directives.

Besides the above, the Club has a set of measures and procedures for our staff and stakeholders to ensure we are managing our workplace and back-of-house safely and hygienically.

BYE-LAW & CONTROL ORDER

CGC MC has approved a set of Bye-Law and Control Order to empower our committee members, staff and authorised Enforcement

Officers to enforce safe management measures. They will be empowered to enforce compliance, cease the activity, deny entry, order departure from the Club's premises, report to MC for disciplinary action and/or report the incident to the Police or relevant government agency.

We hope to impress upon members that these are not meant to restrict your enjoyment, but to do so in a responsible and mindful manner. We appeal for your understanding, patience and cooperation – it will not be "business-as-usual" at Changi Golf Club.

I am sure no member wants CGC to be associated with a COVID-19 case or to be ordered to suspend operations for infringing and flouting safe management measures.

We seek your cooperation to enjoy the Club "safely" and play golf "safely".
